Currently, 55.8% of the 63,114 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 35.9%, renter occupied; and 8.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 59,848 housing units in the area - 57.2% owner occupied, 34.5% renter occupied, and 8.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.39%. Median home value in the area is \$332,902, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.51% annually to \$395,627.

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
